To claim your FREE commission email us on [feedback@knowledge-river.co.uk](mailto:feedback@knowledge-river.co.uk) (*after* they have made their purchase) and confirm the following details:

1. The name of the friend, colleague or acquaintance who made the purchase
2. Their email address (for verification)
3. The amount of money they spent with Knowledge River (for the calculation)
4. Your email address (for any clarification)
5. Your PayPal account name\* (to forward your commission to)

We will pay your commission directly to you **only via PayPal** so you need to tell us your PayPal account name (or go to [www.paypal.com](http://www.paypal.com) and set one up quickly and easily *before* emailing us to claim your money).

Once we have confirmed all details are valid we will *immediately* forward your commission to you via PayPal – all for you to spend as you like.

### Final Points:

- The rate of commission is fixed at 20% of each completed Knowledge River transaction. This rate is non-negotiable.
- We will pay only a single commission per completed Knowledge River transaction. If two separate people try and claim the same commission we shall seek clarification from the purchaser. Otherwise, all other things being equal, we shall pay the commission to the person who applied first. This decision is final and no other commissions will be issued for that same transaction. One sale, one commission, one beneficiary.
- There is no limit to the number of commissions a single person may claim provided that each commission relates to a different (and completed) Knowledge River transaction. So get recruiting!
- You cannot claim a commission on a transaction that you complete. In other words, you may only claim a commission for *another person's* transaction and if they confirm that you introduced them to Knowledge River.
